

HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR MATRIX SCORE

Your total matrix score is calculated by adding the points earned from your core GPA and each of the three Admissions Test sections from the IOWA Assessment:

$$\text{GPA points} + \text{Reading Test points} + \text{Language Test points} + \text{Math Test points} = \text{Total Matrix points}$$

The total matrix score must meet these requirements:

- **88** points to enter 9th grade
- **98** points to enter 10th grade
- **108** points to enter 11th grade

Applicants must have a 2.0 GPA or higher in core academic courses, calculated as: A=4 points, B=3 points, C=2 points, D=1 point.

Core GPA Courses

- **Students entering 9th grade:**
English, Math, Science, and Social Studies
- **Students entering 10th grade:**
English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language (if taken)
- **Students entering 11th grade:**
All 9th-grade courses plus current 10th-grade English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language

*GPA Calculations are based on grades from current school year report card (either the first semester, trimester, or first two quarters, depending on how your current school issues grades). **For incoming 11th graders, it includes the GPAs from both 9th grade and the current 10th grade.**
